There is no I in team, but there is a We in Wekeela

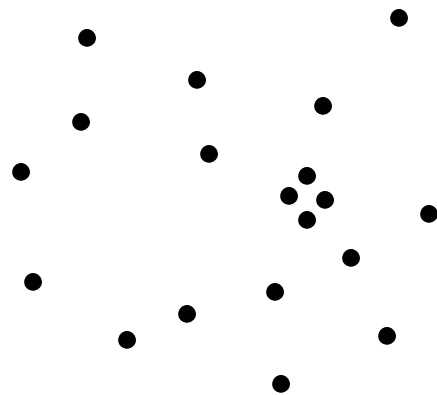
